Hello Mr. Weber,

There are several reasons for our change in the revised study area, including:

recent confirmation of GE 1.6MW turbines as the technology to be used meant required siting for 14 turbines. We had previously considered Siemens 2.3MW turbines which would have only required 10 turbine sites;

field work undertaken over the past couple of years identified a need to consider additional lands to site turbines in order to avoid impacts to natural features;

interest from additional landowners to take part in the project subsequently allowed us to expand the area, and look at better site designs which could avoid potential impacts to natural features.

Dear Mr. Dudek,

Thanks very much for your informative reply to my questions re: turbine siting and access routes. My reading of the maps indicates that turbines 14 and 15 are unlikely to interfere with our satellite signal but we would be grateful for the more technically-robust assessment that your study would provide.

Our greatest concern from the outset has been with the prospect of Sideroad 50 being opened. It is reassuring to know that this is not in NextEra's plans. The road allowance is indeed heavily wooded and also passes through a low, wet area. Clearing the trees would eliminate our entire privacy barrier to the property next door and would also create a direct public access route to our major woodland, for which we have recently signed a managed forest agreement. These impacts would, in our view, be devastating.

Thank you again for your prompt and detailed reply. It is greatly appreciated.

Dear Sir:

I must say, I am totally against these wind turbines. Not only are they a very UN-Godly sight, but are a health hazard to humans and animals alike.

Having said that, I have no actual proof.

I have, however, lived in areas where these were placed, (in Europe) and know from the people living directly around them, that they had heart related issues. This was also the case of the animals living on their farms. Studies done on these, were regularly reported in the newspapers, as well as on the television news. It always came back to the fact that because the wind turbines displace air, it causes heart tremors and irregularity. In some reports, animals were found to be dead. People in the area I lived in were regularly sick and seeing the doctor.

In one instance, the city I lived in, lost one of its turbine mill as it came hurtling towards a nearby farm house, destroying it and the barn. It was lucky that no one was hurt.

As I did not live within the range, it did not directly involve me, and as I was not planning on staying there, I didn't take much notice.
